How to install the K-Mat Heavy Duty Roadway Panels



Preparation

It is recommended that the ground is graded and levelled before use. Ideally a non-woven filtration textile should be laid.



Installation

The mats should be lifted by specialist equipment such as a Hiab or Heavy Duty Forklift. Safely move the K-Mat OL Heavy Duty Roadway Panels whilst being guided by another person. Please ensure correct manual handling procedures are followed.



Connection

Overlay the mat edges together and secure in place with Cam Locks (full size mat), or tighten with Bolts (half size mat).
